Whaddup is a youth program held on Friday nights during school term in Toowoomba for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander youth aged 10-17 years.

We operate within a drug and alcohol-free environment and provide a safe space for youths to be themselves. We provide pick up to and from the venue for all participants for life education activities and dinner, while focusing on reinforcing healthy lifestyle choices and deterring youth from risk taking behaviours.

The WHADDUP program provides an awesome space to celebrate and strengthen connection to country. Elders, parents and volunteers promote social connectedness and play a valuable role in helping shape relationships with each other and build a strong community for the future.
