(Toowoomba Refugee and Migrant Support)

We recognise that our growing population is becoming increasingly diverse and adjusting to living in a new culture and society can be strange, complex and overwhelming.

Our TRAMS program provides refugees and migrants who are new to our region, with support to get settled into community life as soon and as fully as possible.

We can offer assistance with the settlement process after the first twelve months of arrival and up to five years post arrival and can provide support through:

We offer group classes with volunteer support to help you learn about finances, healthy lifestyles factors, providing referrals and assisting with casework and employment education to support your family in Australia.
